By demanding products from sustainably managed forests, we aim to stimulate the improvement of forest management and discourage unsustainable management practices.

We at Procladd (Scotland) Ltd will give preference to suppliers who can demonstrate that their products originate from sustainably managed forests. We consider it important that the origin of our wood-based products can be demonstrated through credible, independent Chain of Custody certification based on international standards and norms. In this context, we recognize credible third-party certification systems accepted by government procurement policies and guidelines, such as the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) and the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC).

It is the responsibility of all Directors, Staff and Sub-Contractors of Procladd (Scotland) Ltd to be aware of and assist in the achievement of these aims. Progress is regularly reviewed through established targets and feedback is actively welcomed.


